

A Safe Workplace is a Fundamental Right for Young Workers

Your employer must correct health and safety hazards.
You can ask about hazards – your employer cannot retaliate when you do.

You also have the right to:

- Ask questions about your job and how to do it safely
- Speak-up when you have a safety concern
- Be trained on your job, oriented to the workplace, and supervised during work
- Receive safety equipment, such as a harness, safety glasses, and gloves.
- Understand workplace hazards and avoid dangerous jobs
- Report an illness or injury
- Be protected from excessive weather, including heat
- Call OSHA and speak to an inspector
